

Shock Isolation Mounts MRAP Vehicle

With the requirement to increase the survivability of Soldiers and Marines involved in roadside IED bombings in Iraq and Afghanistan, the U.S. Department of Defense has ramped up production of a number of variants of "Mine Resistant Ambush Protected" MRAP vehicles to offer better protection for our troops.

From the initial request by the marines, the number and variants has grown considerably as reports grew that roadside bomb attacks and fatalities were down almost 99% partially due to MRAPs.

"They've taken hits, many, many hits that would have killed Soldiers and Marines in unarmored Humvees," according to Adm. Michael Mullen, chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.
